



“Goodie Doll” Pattern

Our “Goodie Dolls” are small toys that have a blanket crocheted around them. These lovies provide comfort to children who may be suffering trauma, need a distraction when receiving medical treatment or something soft to cuddle in their time of need. ROUND1: Make an adjustable ring (magic ring) making sure you leave about a 15cm tail to use at the end of the project to tie/sew your Blankie onto your soft toy.

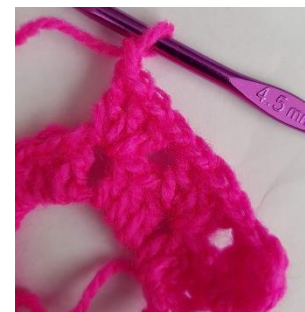
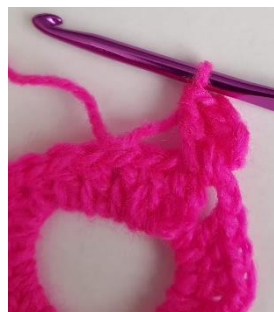


Ch 2, 2dc into magic ring, Ch1 (This is your first cell of 3 dc).

Next *3 dc and ch 1 into the ring. Repeat from * 6 times so that you have 8 cells of 3 double crochet in your magic ring. Join with a slip stitch into the top of the ch 2.



ROUND 2: Ch 2, 2 dc into the same space as the first ch 2 keeping slightly right of the first cell of RND 2. Next *3 dc into the next 2 chain spaces. Ch1 then 2dc into the same space as the last cell of three dc. This will be your corner.



Continue to do the same for the last three sides of your square. Slip stitch to the top of the first two chains to join.

ROUND 3: Continue to crochet until the square reaches no less than 35cm square.
